
SEPARATION OF POWERS

- Described by Baron de Montesquieu in 17th century
- Political power is generally divided into 3 branches

Montesquieu 's model

- 3 branches executive, legislature, judiciary
- Based on British constitutional system
- the British system was no so independent

Presidential government


Parliamentary government

- Each branch has some power to limit another branch




Another branches
